JESUS MOVEMENT OF 2017 VS CHURCH OF 1960's







Congregational Characteristics




Percentage of Churches Growing and Declining by in CGC and Episcopal Church




Change in Average Sunday Attendance (5 Years)

1 : to expose to hazard : RISK, GAMBLE • ventured a buck or two on the race


2 : to undertake the risks and dangers of : BRAVE • ventured the stormy sea

4 steps needed to affect change/transformation


- 1. Get proximate = be curious
- 2. Change the narrative = be creative
- 3. Do something uncomfortable = be courageous
 - 4. Be hopeful

Fear of loss

We want chapels more than we want churches

We wait on people that will never change



PRINCIPLES IN THE DESIGN OF CEV

- 1. Peer to peer = learn better in community
- 2. Praxis = Take it home & try it
- 3. Appropriated to your context
- 4. Prayer=put something in your weekly prayers
- 5. Accountability = Team approach
- 6. Process = This is not a C & E event
- 7. Flexibility = a venture means we are open to changing direction
