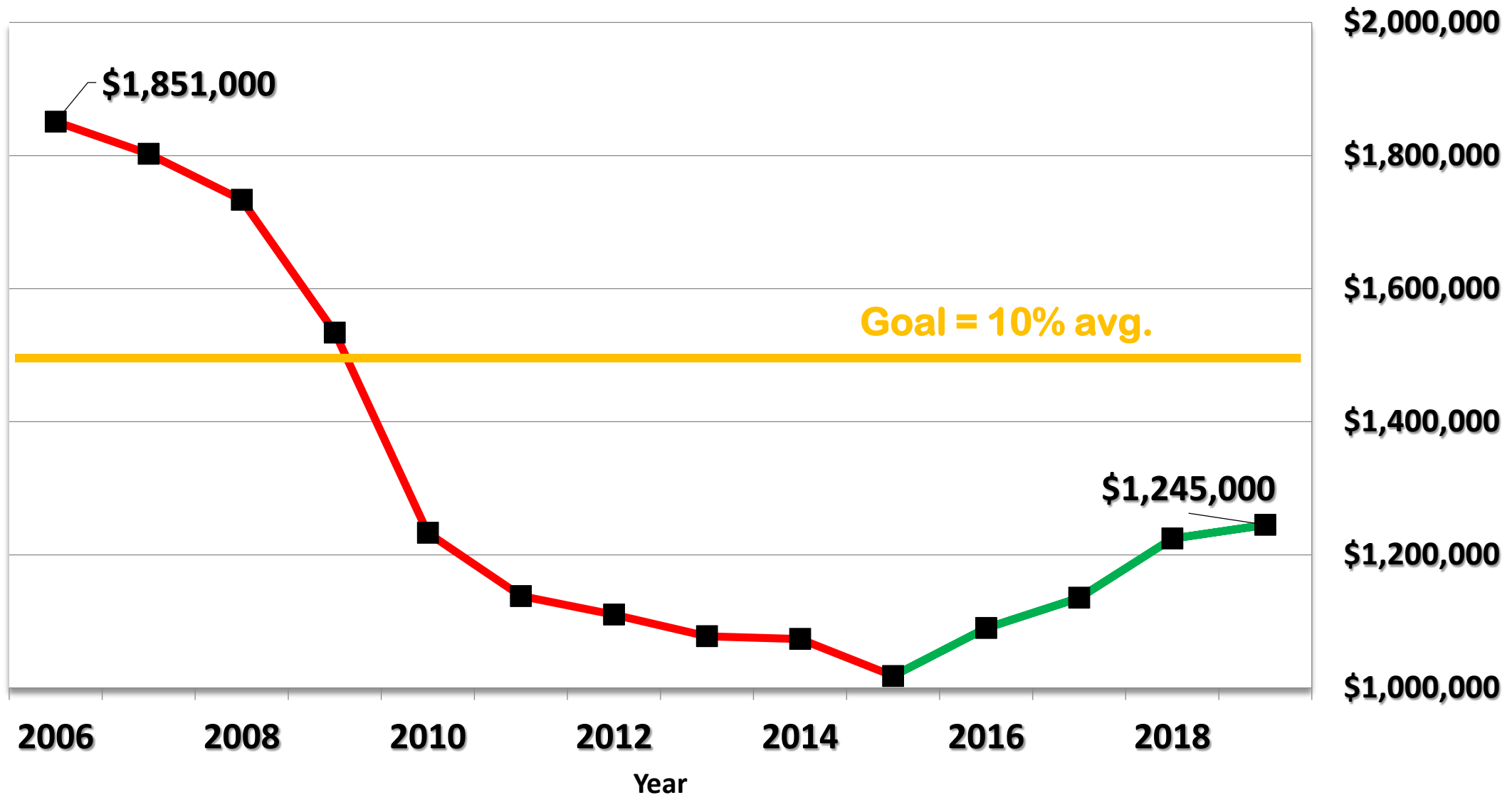

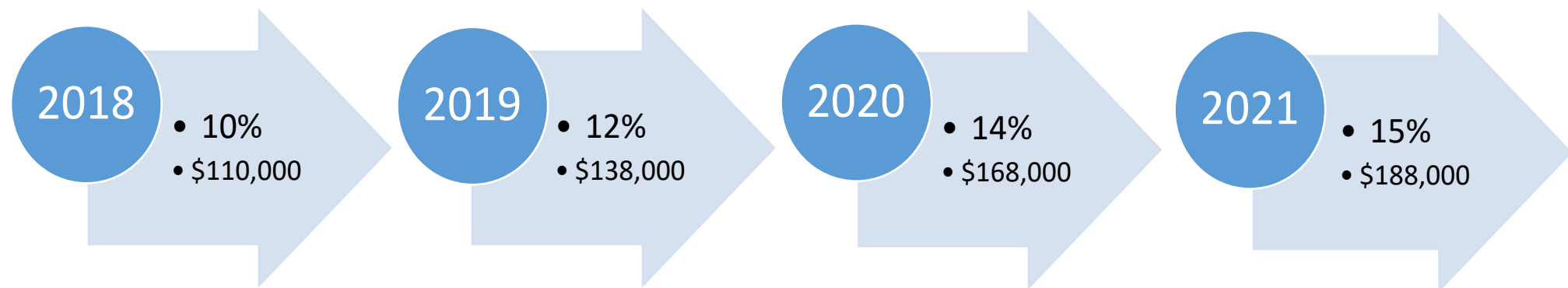

Key Budget Challenge *DFMS Pledge = 15%*

- DFMS (*Domestic and Foreign Missionary Society - the name under which the Episcopal Church is incorporated, conducts business and carries out mission*) now assesses mandatory 15% on income.
- Our fair share to TEC - needed to do the mission and program work of the Episcopal Church here and abroad.
- We've committed to meeting this obligation: allows us to be eligible for TEC grants and committee membership.

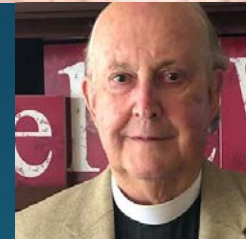
