WHO MAKES THE DECISION?

AM I ELIGIBLE?

You are eligible if you meet the following requirements...

- You are active in the life of the Episcopal Church
- You (or your parents/guardian) are a member of a congregation in our Diocese
- You are advancing your education through a certified, accredited institution (including Associates, Bachelors, Masters, etc.)
- Note: Seminarians are not eligible for these scholarships

HOW DO I APPLY?

There are a few steps to follow in the application process:

- 1. Fill out the application form
- 2. Obtain official transcript(s) from your most recent academic work
- 3. Obtain letter of reference (sealed / signed envelope)
- 4. Complete your essay (select only one question to answer)
- 5. Turn a complete application and supporting documents into Dwight Babcock, Diocesan Administrator, at the Diocesan Office on or before May 25 due date OR mail to:
